<p><b>R</b> EADY TO LEARN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I pay attention at all times.</li> <li>• I am always enthusiastic and positive.</li> <li>• I always complete work to the best of my ability.</li> <li>• I am organised and always have my equipment.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Arrive to lessons on time and with all the equipment you need.</li> <li>• Show enthusiasm by asking questions.</li> <li>• Make eye contact with the teacher and other learners.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Listen actively and display positive body language.</li> <li>• Attend extra sessions offered to you.</li> <li>• Put the hours in at home.</li> <li>• Be prepared to make mistakes.</li> </ul>
